On this date, your child will have the opportunity to participate along with 5,000 students, teachers, principals, and educators who are dedicated to outdoor education in the state of Maryland. The Maryland Green Schools Youth Summit will enable schools to showcase environmental activities to their peers and empower students to create a greener world. Students will get to attend an environmental literacy program, Green Olympic games, dance party, nature hikes, and leadership sessions. We believe students will have an interesting and exciting day as they connect this experience to the content of their greening experience here at ACCE.

Permission slips need to be received by Thursday, May 24, 2012 to your child's science teacher. A list of students attending will be posted inside every Science Teachers room. If students are not present at ACCE to board the bus and depart on time on June 1st, they will have to attend their regular classes at ACCE for the rest of the day. Students will need to ride to/from the summit on the BCPSS provided transportation. Upon return to school, students will be dismissed.
